

SALT ASSAULT



Despite soggy salt flat conditions that scrubbed off speed, a race-prepped Victory piloted by James Crosby (left) posted a speed of 118 mph during the BUB Motorcycle Speed Trials on the Bonneville Salt Flats in September. The bike was built by Matt Waring of MBW Motorcycle Products, a Victory accessories specialist. Due to the poor conditions, Matt and James made only four runs on the salt, including one where the bike snapped sideways at the entry gate, so James shut it down. After coasting with the engine off for a full mile, his finish line speed was still 102 mph! "We figure he came into the traps in the 140s or so," Matt said. "We're addicted and we have plans for additional speed events" with the bike that has been dyno'ed at 140-plus horsepower. Watch for updates on the Victory website.
